The Legacy of Mother Pearl Clark

Mother Pearl Clark was born in Myles, Mississippi in 1887. She was a devoted Christian woman who feared and loved the Lord. She demonstrated that love by her unselfish generosity and concern for others.

She achieved her formal higher education at Jackson State College (now Jackson State University) in Jackson, Mississippi and earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Tougaloo College in Tougaloo, Mississippi. Mother Clark worked with single mothers in Mississippi, Pennsylvania, and Washington, DC. She diligently taught school in DC at the Nannie Helen Burroughs School for girls for many years until she retired.



While residing in DC, Sister Clark united with the Church of Christ (Holiness) movement. She saw the church needed a building for worship services. Through her humble prayers, the Lord blessed Sister Clark. In 1932, by the goodness and generosity of Sister Clark, the members were able to obtain their first church building in NW, Washington, DC. As the years passed the building was sold to help purchase the land and finance the present church structure located at 1219 Hamlin Street, NE, Washington, DC.

Mother Pearl Clark was a faithful Sunday School teacher, member of the Trustee Board, member of the Christian Women Willing Workers (CWWW) and a Mother of the Church. She was the personification of "selfless generosity." For this reason we honor Mother Clark with a scholarship in her name.

The Lord called Mother Clark home from her labors on December 25, 1975, at the age of 88.

The Pearl Clark Scholarship Fund (PCSF) was established in 1980 in honor of the late Mother Pearl Clark. Mother Clark gave of her means to assist ministers and young people in their pursuit of higher education.

Scholarship Eligibility

Under the Pearl Clark Scholarship Fund, scholarships and book awards are provided to first time collegebound and returning undergraduate students. To be eligible for an award students must:



- Be a member of First Church
- Maintain at least a 2.5 average
- Be enrolled in an academic institution
